The Center Then and Now

On April 26, 1971, a small group of pro-life women had a vision to get life-saving information to women in a crisis pregnancy by setting up a 24-hour helpline called LIFELINE based in San Pedro. This was three years before Roe v. Wade, and abortion was already legal in California. This vision grew to an in-person facility in Torrance in 1976 (pictured is Sue Lester) and eventually became the only licensed pregnancy medical clinic in the South Bay in 1991.



Through all the transitions, the Center continued to provide compassionate care and education to women with an unplanned pregnancy. A thank you note from Dana, a client in 1976, praised the Center's support, "I want to thank you all for everything you've done for me. I don't know what I would have done if you people wouldn't have been there. I will always remember the kindness that was done for me."

Fast forward 45 years and clients like Tina are getting the same supportive care. Tina didn't have insurance or a doctor, so she searched online for a clinic and found the Center. She stated, "A lot of places were only doing abortion services due to COVID which led me here." Tina had a prior pregnancy which ended in a miscarriage, and she was concerned. "They made me feel very welcome and informed me on ways to get information on pregnancy I wouldn't have known about otherwise." Tina's baby is due in July, and a



Center client advocate continues to check on Tina periodically to see how she is doing and if there is any other assistance we can provide.

The determination of a few Christ-centered women 50 years ago has given *thousands* of women courage to choose life for their babies.

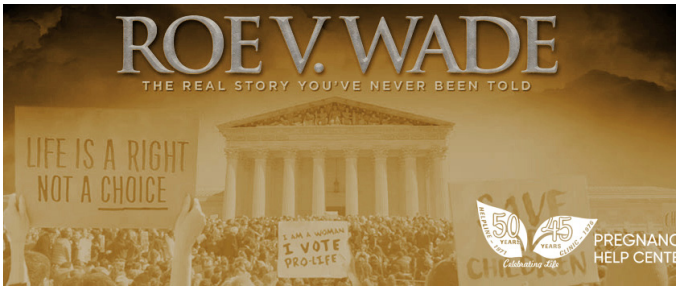

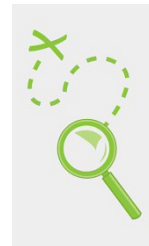
34th Annual (Virtual) Walk for Life South Bay/ Celebrating Life Scavenger Hunt
