Against All Odds

Despite the pandemic and its adverse effects, in 2021 83% of our abortion-vulnerable clients chose life after seeing their baby on an ultrasound. Your support along with the dedication of our client advocates and nurses made this possible.

A recent client in an unstable relationship came to the clinic for a pregnancy test. Without family nearby, she felt very alone. Client advocate Linda was able to work with her through her concerns. After the appointment, Linda tried to contact her to follow up, but her number was not in service. Not one to give up easily, Linda continued to try the number again, and this time it miraculously went through. The client came back to the clinic and Nurse Donna introduced her to her baby on the ultrasound. Because of the loving support she received, she started prenatal care.

Another client and her husband came to the clinic feeling fearful about having a third child. Although their minds were set on abortion, the husband said if there was a heartbeat, they would have the baby. Based on Nurse Victoria's estimation of the baby's age, the client qualified for an ultrasound. Incredibly, the baby had a visible heartbeat at 5 weeks and 5 days old! Victoria said they have never seen a heartbeat so early in such a small baby. It was truly a God-given miracle. The client started crying and told us, "You know, these are tears of joy. I think I am going to be OK."

Alarming Rise in Chemical Abortions

Easy access to abortion pills threatens to reverse the sustained decline in abortions we have experienced over the last three decades.

Due to heavy lobbying by Planned Parenthood, the FDA has permanently modified the Risk Evaluation and Mitigation Strategy (REMS) for chemical abortion pills, allowing women to receive the life-threatening (to mother and baby) pills through the mail without a medical exam.



The number of chemical abortions has been steadily growing, and according to Guttmacher Institute accounts for 54% of abortions in 2020 compared to 44% in 2019. These numbers are likely to continue to increase given the heavy publicity of telemedicine by abortion groups.
