She Still Needs You

On June 24th, we were blessed with a great victory: the fall of Roe v. Wade. Pro-life warriors like you have been working to help people recognize the humanity of the preborn child, paving the way for this historical moment. Your support of the Center's clients has changed hearts and given hope to women in difficult situations, like Crystal.

When Crystal found herself unexpectedly pregnant, her boyfriend was terrified. He insisted she have an abortion. She had no one else to rely on; her family was based overseas, and they didn't take the news well. She felt conflicted and alone when she found the Center.

After a positive pregnancy test, Crystal was scheduled for an ultrasound. When she saw her baby for the first time on the monitor, she stated her heart fluttered and she was so excited to see his little silhouette. A client advocate discussed her concerns with her and reassured her of the Center's assistance and resources.

Crystal had her baby, Logan, in June. By participating in the Center's BrightCourse classes, she redeemed points for free baby supplies for him. Her family also warmed up to her situation and are helping her from overseas. Crystal is glad she pulled through that tough time, "I had an unexpected pregnancy, but I chose to keep him. I love him to death."



Though Roe is defeated, women like Crystal continue to need our compassion and support. CA legislature is turning the state into an abortion hub, and we expect to see a rise in women traveling to the state for abortion. Our work to foster a culture of life is really just beginning, but we praise and thank God for your partnership with us to do this critical work.

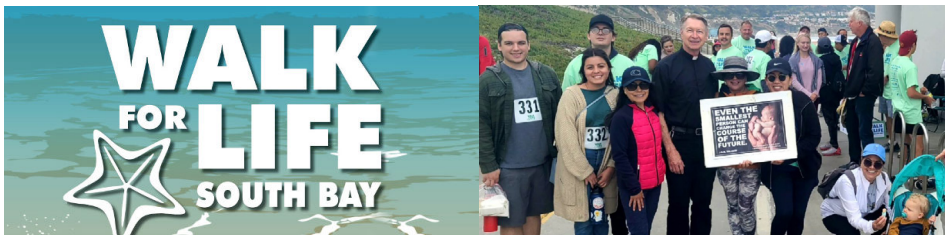
