Answering God's Call

Amid the hustle and bustle of running the Center, every so often we encounter a moment so miraculous that we're compelled to step back and marvel at God's hand at work. Victoria our Clinic Services Director was blessed with such a moment recently.

Victoria was in the clinic past midnight, working late to finish up a report, when she heard the phone ring. As it was well after hours, she knew that a volunteer manning the helpline would respond, so she let the call rollover and continued on with her report. However, a few minutes later, the phone rang again. She let the call roll to the helpline once again. However, it rang for the third time, with the same caller ID. She decided to unroll the line in case it happened once more. Sure enough, the phone rang a fourth time, and she took the call.

The caller was a Spanish speaker who was panicking because she had taken the abortion pill and regretted her decision. She was holding out hope that we could help her save her baby. Fortunately, Victoria is fluent in Spanish and trained to handle such emergencies. She swiftly provided the caller with education about the Abortion Pill Reversal (APR) process and referred her to the APR Network.

Afterwards, Victoria reached out to APR to offer translation services and financial assistance for the caller's medication, as well as ultrasound exams as needed. To protect client confidentiality, the APR operator was not able to divulge any information but was able to share that she had received five calls since midnight. We have hope that our Spanish-speaking caller was one of them.

As for the volunteer manning the helpline, it turns out that she had answered the phone, but the caller kept hanging up on her. That left Victoria, a Spanish-speaking nurse working overtime in the clinic to respond to the call. God had provided exactly what our caller needed!

Our staff and volunteers are able to offer women and their preborn babies the practical assistance they need because of your support. Thank YOU for making these extraordinary moments possible.
