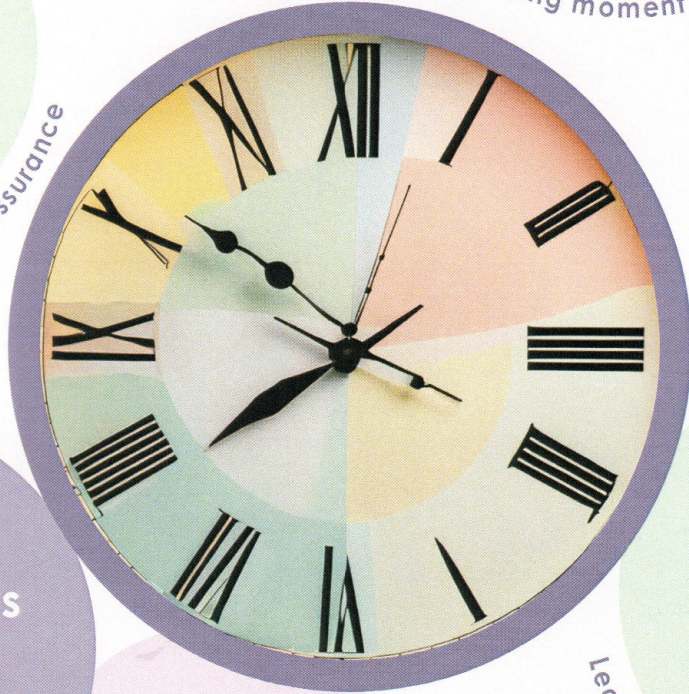

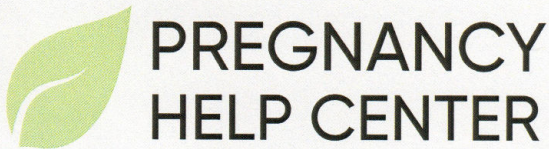

OUR MISSION

To provide a safe, caring environment where every woman facing a crisis pregnancy can receive information, education, and practical assistance in order to eliminate the crisis and choose life for her baby; and to inspire others to embrace sexual health and integrity.

From the Executive Director and Board Chairperson

Dear Friends,

When an abortion-vulnerable woman chooses life, it is a powerful moment that cascades into a ripple of generational change. Since opening 48 years ago, we marvel at how that brave decision saves not only one baby's life, but the lives of entire families as that baby grows up within their family and, one day, has children of their own. It becomes an enduring legacy that echoes through generations.

Unfortunately, our life-changing work continues to be under threat in California. The state's Attorney General, Rob Bonta, has been working hard to cast doubt on the legitimacy of pregnancy medical clinics like ours. He is investigating our counterparts' medical services and accusing them of false advertising regarding abortion pill reversal. This is an attempt to stop women who regretted taking the abortion pill mifepristone, sought help from the Abortion Pill Reversal (APR) Network, and received progesterone treatment under a pro-life doctor's care to continue their pregnancies. Bonta's actions are targeted at undermining pregnancy centers and pro-life ministries, disadvantaging vulnerable women who might otherwise choose life after taking chemical abortion pills.

With the FDA's permanent removal of necessary safety precautions and medical oversight, these pills now account for over 50% of abortions but that number is expected to reach 80% by year end. With the ability to access the abortion pill online, often from a nonmedical provider, women are now steered away from life-affirming resources and into the arms of abortion providers. However, our Center recently celebrated a success story involving a client who had taken mifepristone. After referring her to the APR Network, where we serve as a consulting center, she completed a progesterone regimen. A follow-up ultrasound at 9 1/2 weeks confirmed a healthy pregnancy and baby!



While we experienced an initial decline in client numbers after the Dobbs decision in 2022, we have since seen our numbers rebound by 10%. We served 674 pregnancy test clients in 2023 and 418 in 2024 year to date. We ask for your unceasing prayers and support so we may continue to create a space for these lifesaving moments to occur. As Isaiah 40:31 reminds us, "Those who hope in the Lord will renew their strength...and not grow weary."

ALL IT TAKES IS ONE MOMENT

There is a precious moment in time when a woman chooses to give her preborn child a second chance at life. As a consulting center for the Abortion Pill Reversal Network (APRN), every so often we are blessed with the opportunity to support her in that moment when she reaches out for help after taking mifepristone, the first of two abortion pills.

A recent client came to us because she regretted taking mifepristone and wanted to know if she could save her baby. We quickly referred her to the APRN which connected her with an OB/GYN trained in the Abortion Pill Reversal process. The doctor prescribed a regimen of progesterone to support the pregnancy. After completing the course of progesterone, the client returned to our clinic for an ultrasound, and thankfully it showed a healthy baby!

Another client walked in a few days before Christmas. She had reached out to the APRN after taking mifepristone and was similarly started on progesterone. She was now desperate to know how her baby was doing. Fortunately, the ultrasound given at the Center was normal and, by the grace of God, the reversal was working.

There are many more babies who are saved that we don't get to hear about. We often refer clients to the APRN but, because of privacy practices, they cannot tell us whether they received the call, only that they've received a certain number of calls. However, once in a while, God sends a client back to us, and we get to celebrate in the joy of that precious moment when the love of a mother triumphs over fear. We are able to provide APR consulting because of YOUR partnership; thank you for creating these special moments!
