

Seeing is Believing.

That's the truth we witness every day in our clinic—when a woman sees the first flicker of life on an ultrasound screen, it often becomes the moment everything changes. The moment fear begins to give way to hope. The moment a choice for life becomes possible.

Since our founding 49 years ago, we have seen how one courageous "yes" to life can ripple through generations. A child is born. A family is transformed. And one day, that child may become a parent too, raising the next generation to value life.

Through God's grace and your generosity, we've expanded our life-saving mission with a new 2,000-square-foot satellite clinic—welcoming, beautiful, and ready to serve more abortion-vulnerable women with life-affirming care. We began offering services at this location in late March, marking a major step toward becoming a more visible, accessible, and compassionate resource for women facing unplanned pregnancies.

Thanks to the incredible generosity of our local Knights of Columbus, our satellite clinic now has a high-resolution ultrasound machine that empowers women to vividly see their babies for the first time. It's a powerful moment that can make all the difference- seeing a beating heart, a tiny arm, or a first flutter of movement.

Our main clinic at 1311 Crenshaw remains open as well. Both locations can serve clients with the same free, high-quality medical services and supportive care we've been known for.

Because of your continued support, every service we offer remains 100% free: pregnancy testing, limited obstetric ultrasounds, options counseling, abortion pill reversal referrals, parenting education, and material assistance. Every woman who walks through our doors is met with compassion, truth, and tangible support at no cost to her.

And it's working for women like Susan, Maria, Carmen, and Rose who shared their joy in meeting their preborn babies on an ultrasound, because when a woman sees her baby... she believes.

As we near 50 years of serving women with truth, hope, and the belief in the beauty and sanctity of life, we thank you for standing with us in our mission to protect and preserve life. As Jesus said, "Blessed are those who have not seen and yet have believed" (John 20:29)—and how much greater the blessing when women both see and believe. Together, we are planting seeds of faith, love, and life—one heartbeat, one child, one family at a time.

He and his wife Rhonda attend American Martyrs Catholic church and have two daughters and four grandchildren. Jerry owns Rainforest Flora Inc., an exotic plant nursery.



Many clients walk through the clinic doors feeling lost, overwhelmed, and uncertain. Some face pressure to abort from the baby's father, family members, or friends—often minimizing the lasting physical and emotional effects of abortion.

A client advocate discusses the client's fears and challenges, while a nurse confirms a viable pregnancy via ultrasound by checking for a heartbeat, ruling out ectopic pregnancy, and determining gestational age.

A fetal heartbeat can be seen as early as six weeks, and 86% of abortion-vulnerable women will choose life after meeting their preborn baby on an ultrasound.

Susan shared, "The ultrasound made me emotional and determined to have the baby." The ultrasound was Maria's decisive moment, and she said, "I see the baby and he or she is alive." Rose told us that when she saw the baby on the ultrasound, "A switch went off in my head making it real." Carmen cried when she saw her preborn baby, "It was the first time I got to see what was inside my body." "That's my grandchild, we are keeping the baby," stated a dad who was determined that his daughter she should have an abortion.

YOU are the reason these women chose life and have the opportunity to see and believe.


